

Postdoctoral position in plant molecular biology

**A postdoctoral research associate position is available at Cornell University in Ithaca, New York**

A postdoc position is available immediately in the Li lab at Cornell University in Ithaca, NY. Our research program focuses on discovering new genes that affect plant metabolite levels and elucidating their regulatory mechanisms. The postdoc will lead research efforts to investigate the regulatory control of carotenoid metabolism and is encouraged to develop or explore research projects in the related areas.

**Qualifications:** Applicants should have a Ph.D. in Plant Biology, Biochemistry, Genetics, or a related field. Successful candidate is highly self-motivated and has a good track record of first author publication, plus strong skills in molecular biology, genetics, and biochemistry. Experience with Arabidopsis plants is desirable but not required.
